DRIVER LICENSE INFORMATION FOR F-1 INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- The process of receiving a Texas driver's license is as follows:
 - **1.** Complete application
 - 2. Make an appointment
 - **3.** Provide documentation
 - **4.** Provide your signature
 - **5.** Provide thumbprints

- **6.** Have your picture taken
- 7. Pay application fee
- **8.** Pass the vision exam
- **9.** Take and pass the knowledge and driving test
- You will need to provide the following documents at the appointment:
 - **Proof of Identity** Passport (+ school ID card (optional))
 - Proof of U.S. Citizenship or Lawful Presence Continued Attendance
 I-20, F-1 Visa, and I-94 (including travel history)
 - Proof Social Security Number or Social Security Number Affidavit
 Form DL-13 (provided at DPS)
 - Proof of Texas Residency (must provide proof resided in Texas for at <u>least</u> 30 days) I-94 (including travel history) + Billing Statement or Contract of Rent/Lease (with current address)
 - Texas Vehicle Registration and Proof of Insurance (Proof of Insurance for each vehicle you own. *If you do not own a vehicle, you will sign a statement affirming this.)
- ➤ If you are a **new F-1 International Student at TCC**, you need to wait to apply for a driver's license until after International Student Admissions & Compliance has sent you your Continued Attendance I-20, which is issued within 30 days from the start of the semester.
- The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) will determine whether you can receive a driver's license and the duration of your driver's license.
- ➤ If you wish to **renew your driver's license**, you must renew it at least 30 days prior to expiration. You will also need to pay the renewal fee. <u>There is no grace period for a driver's license after it expires</u>.
